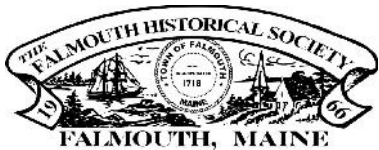

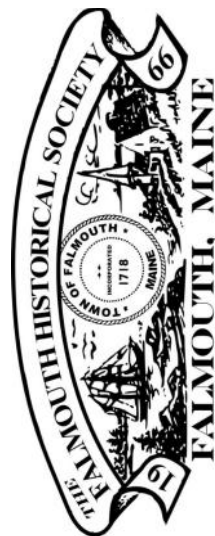

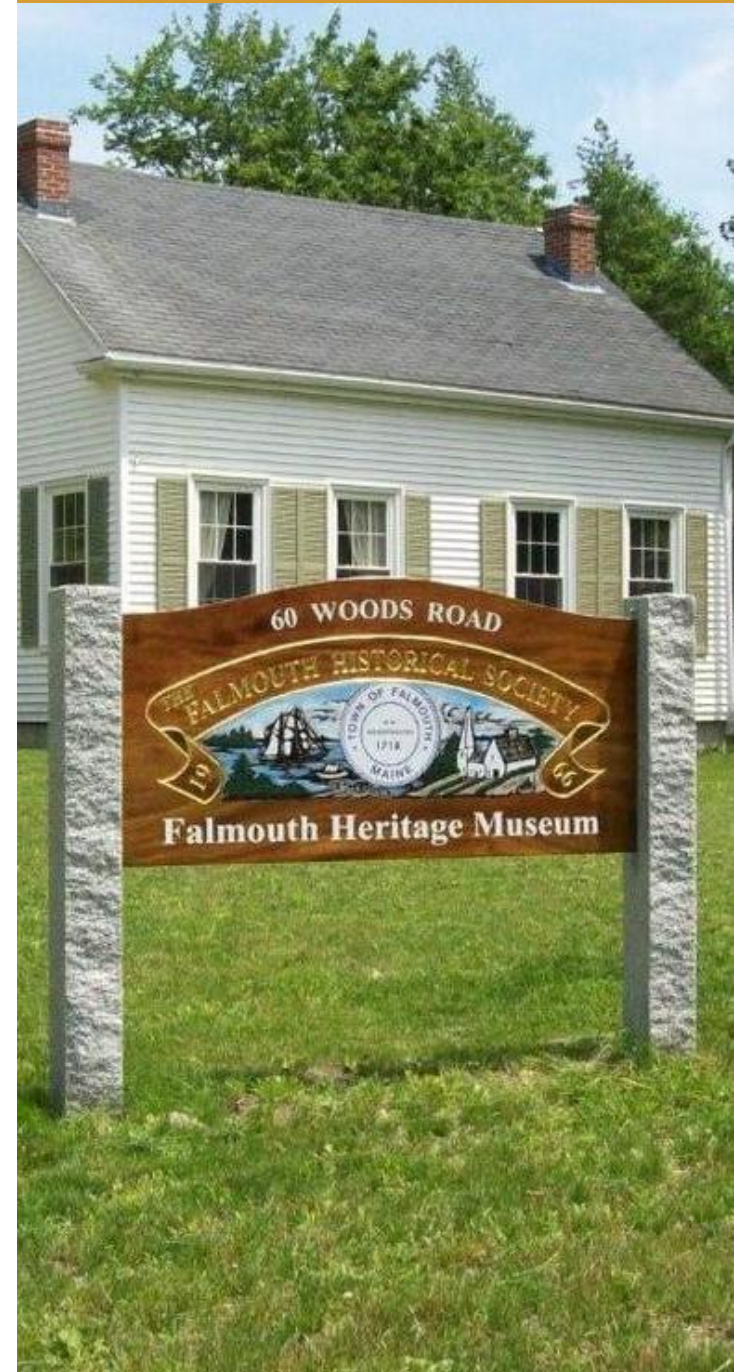

Falmouth Historical Society

The Falmouth Historical Society promotes interest in, and awareness of, Falmouth history and heritage through community education, events and programs. The Society was founded in 1966 by a group of devoted volunteers with the goal of preserving their beloved town's history. To this day, the Society is run solely by volunteers and financially supported by membership dues and donations, as well as investments made by the Society.

The Falmouth Heritage Museum, located on Woods Road, is housed in an 1835 residential home, adjacent to a newly constructed barn. The buildings house the Society's collection of artifacts, photos, and documents, as well as a research library and genealogical resources. Collections include:

- Falmouth Family Genealogies
- Historic Preservation Commission Survey of Falmouth Homes
- Falmouth High School Yearbooks
- American Legion Collection
- 1924 REO Fire Truck
- 19th Century Falmouth-Built Milk Wagon
- Prince Collection of Glass Plate Negatives
- Historical files on Falmouth houses, settlers, roads, churches, clubs, and government.
