Falmouth Heritage Museum—Feb 12, 2019

Secretary's Report

The Annual Meeting and January minutes were reviewed and approved by the Board.

Fred measured the dimensions of the "doll room" upstairs. 360 square feet of wall surface that needs to be removed—this consists of plaster and lathe. The plaster is likely ½ inch thick. To haul this away, we could rent a hydraulic lift trailer but, together with dump costs, the amount will still be \$400-\$500 dollars. We need to think about whether we want to spend that much money now.

We are having a work day at the Museum on Sunday March 16. We have some Yelp volunteers to work with us. We will be scraping and repainting/staining the front door and surrounding woodwork, the kitchen window, and the ramp as well as working on the ditch beside the driveway. The March meeting is the 5th, so we will finalize plans then. We will need to purchase exterior paint, primer, and exterior caulk; we have some insulation downstairs. Several of us will be bringing the needed equipment/tools from our homes. We welcome members and anyone in the community who would like to lend a hand to join us!
